Our students and staff are committed to the craft of storytelling through theatre and are challenging themselves to devise and design by exercising their own voice and telling their own stories. This (X)YMTP is very special to us because it is our very first entirely student-directed show with our very first student-written pieces. We cannot express how proud we are of all of our young people and how much they have grown through the experience of this production.

(X)YMTP began in 2016 with the desire to create opportunities for students to perform more challenging material.

While the X in (X)YMTP originally stood for a variable, meaning "anytime, anywhere," it soon came to be understood as "X for Extreme."




